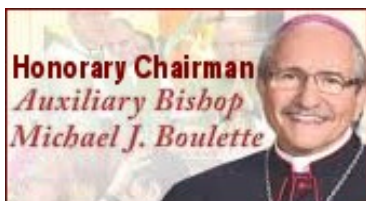

About Allied Women's Center

Since 1994, Allied Women's Center has operated Catholic crisis pregnancy centers in San Antonio which assist over 2,000 women and children annually and now save the lives of hundreds of babies each year from abortion. Allied works on the front lines, at the point of the "life or death" decisions, and supports those women and their families who choose life. Allied operates two center locations in San Antonio and provides free pregnancy tests, compassionate counseling, and 3-D ultrasounds for abortion-minded pregnant women, as well as diapers, cribs, layettes, clothing and other material and financial support for the mothers and families of saved babies.

This year we moved our second location to the far southeast across the street from the Planned Parenthood center there and to better serve clients in south San Antonio and south Texas. But while Allied has achieved an increase in saved babies over time, the annual financial support it receives has remained almost flat. Which means Allied is rapidly depleting its reserves and faces an uncertain future. With diminishing resources, Allied has been forced to cut back on client support which unfortunately has resulted in a lower rate of babies being saved. Even one baby lost due to inadequate resources is too many. That is where faith-filled people like you come in.

It is our hope that you'll come to the Gala, hear the life-saving stories, see many saved babies who will be in attendance and then decide to join other generous pro-life people who support Allied's mission of saving the lives of babies and the souls of their parents.
